With the newest Maineville bank branch, National Bank & Trust rolled out a new building design. This prototype, at 4,400 SF, is larger than former branches, and has wood framing with cast stone accents and brick veneer. A second floor mechanical mezzanine is accessible from stairs inside the building. In addition to preparing the site for National Bank & Trust, Oswald Company also coordinated and installed utilities with the developer of the adjacent sites.

“National Bank & Trust was immediately faced with a cost and scheduling challenge because the desired light fixtures were very costly and would take two months to arrive. We researched the issue and were able to find identical fixtures at a significantly lower cost with a two-week delivery. We ordered these lights for Maineville as well as two other branches being built by other contractors to save NB&T money.”
