## Stadium Building & Parking

Duration: 2 Months (each)

Summit Country Day had the ambitious goal of renovating their stadium during two months of summer vacation. The project involved removing existing bleachers, constructing a building to house restrooms and team rooms, and placing new bleachers atop the structure. A new press box and concession stand sits behind the bleachers. After Oswald successfully completed this project, they were immediately contracted to expand Summit's student parking lot by 78 spaces, which involved the demolition of blighted houses adjacent to the school. An underground retention structure was installed to regulate drainage, and additional landscaping was planted around the parking lot and stadium perimeter.
